S.F. 4314 removes “harassment” from the definition of coerced debt and makes conforming changes to the statute. A person who causes another person to incur coerced debt is civilly liable to the creditor. The bill creates additional notice and service requirements. There is a presumption that the debtor has incurred coerced debt if the person alleged to have caused the debtor to incur the coerced debt has been convicted or received a stay of adjudication of several crimes.
