## S.F. No. 3537 – Prohibition on Junk Fees (as amended by the a-2)

**S.F. 3537** prohibits a person from advertising, displaying, or offering a price for goods or services that does not include all mandatory fees or surcharges. The bill creates requirements for food delivery platforms related to disclosures of additional fees and itemization of fees. A person may charge a reasonable postage or shipping fee and a person may offer goods or services at a discounted price. The bill also requires a person offering goods or services at an auction to make certain disclosures. The provisions in this bill are enforceable to the extent permitted by federal law.
