Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 340A.101, subdivision 13, is amended to

Subd. 13. **Hotel.** "Hotel" is an establishment where food and lodging are regularly

furnished to transients and which has:

(1) a dining room serving the general public at tables and having facilities for seating

at least 30 guests at one time; ~~and~~ or

(2) guest rooms in the following minimum numbers: in first class cities, 50; in second

class cities, ~~25~~ 20; in all other cities and unincorporated areas, 10.
