1.7 169.222, subdivisions 6a, 6b; 174.75, subdivisions 1, 2, by adding a subdivision; Minnesota
1.8 Statutes 2023 Supplement, sections 169.011, subdivision 27; 171.0705, subdivision 2;
1.9 171.13, subdivision 1; Laws 2023, chapter 68, article 1, section 20; proposing coding for
1.10 new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 325F.

1.11 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:


1.12 Page 2, delete section 4
