1.6 Subdivision 1. **Application; contents.** (a) Except as otherwise provided in this
1.7 subdivision, the provisions of this chapter relating to license applications, license selection
1.8 criteria, general ownership disqualifications and requirements, and general operational
1.9 requirements do not apply to hemp businesses.

1.10 (b) The office, by rule, shall establish forms and procedures for the processing of hemp
1.11 licenses issued under this chapter. At a minimum, any application to obtain or renew a hemp
1.12 license shall include the following information, if applicable:

1.13 (1) the name, address, and date of birth of the applicant;

1.14 (2) the address and legal property description of the business;

1.15 (3) proof of trade name registration;

1.16 (4) certification that the applicant will comply with the requirements of this chapter
1.17 relating to the ownership and operation of a hemp business;

1.18 (5) identification of one or more controlling persons or managerial employees as agents
1.19 who shall be responsible for dealing with the office on all matters; and

1.20 (6) a statement that the applicant agrees to respond to the office's supplemental requests
1.21 for information.

1.23 ~~attestation signed by a bona fide labor organization stating that the applicant has entered~~
