- (b) The office, by rule, shall establish forms and procedures for the processing of hemp
 licenses issued under this chapter. At a minimum, any application to obtain or renew a hemp
 license shall include the following information, if applicable:
- 1.13 (1) the name, address, and date of birth of the applicant;
- 1.14 (2) the address and legal property description of the business;
- 1.15 (3) proof of trade name registration;
- 1.16 (4) certification that the applicant will comply with the requirements of this chapter
- 1.17 relating to the ownership and operation of a hemp business;
- 1.18 (5) identification of one or more controlling persons or managerial employees as agents1.19 who shall be responsible for dealing with the office on all matters; and
- 1.20 (6) a statement that the applicant agrees to respond to the office's supplemental requests1.21 for information.
- 1.22 (c) An applicant for a lower-potency hemp edible manufacturer license must submit an
- 1.23 attestation signed by a bona fide labor organization stating that the applicant has entered
- 1.24 into a labor peace agreement.
- 1.25 (d) (c) An application on behalf of a corporation or association shall be signed by at
 1.26 least two officers or managing agents of that entity."
