## 342.16 CANNABIS BUSINESSES; GENERAL OWNERSHIP

## DISQUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS.

- (a) A license holder or applicant must meet each of the following requirements, if applicable, to hold or receive a cannabis license issued under this chapter:
- (1) be at least 21 years of age;

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- 1.10 (2) have completed an application for licensure or application for renewal;
- 1.11 (3) have paid the applicable application fee and license fee;
- 1.12 (4) if the applicant or license holder is a business entity, be incorporated in the state or otherwise formed or organized under the laws of the state;
- 1.14 (5) not be employed by the office or any state agency with regulatory authority under
  this chapter or the rules adopted pursuant to this chapter;
- 1.16 (6) not be a licensed peace officer, as defined in section 626.84, subdivision 1, paragraph
  1.17 (c);
  - (7) never have had a license previously issued under this chapter revoked, and never had a cannabis license, registration, agreement, or other authorization to operate a cannabis business issued under the laws of another state revoked;
