

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 4451 as follows:

1.2 Page 2, after line 24, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 121A.2207, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.4 Subdivision 1. **Districts and schools permitted to maintain supply.** (a) Notwithstanding
1.5 section 151.37, districts and schools may obtain and possess epinephrine auto-injectors to
1.6 be maintained and administered by school personnel to a student or other individual if, in
1.7 good faith, it is determined that person is experiencing anaphylaxis regardless of whether
1.8 the student or other individual has a prescription for an epinephrine auto-injector. The
1.9 administration of an epinephrine auto-injector in accordance with this section is not the
1.10 practice of medicine.

1.11 (b) Registered nurses may administer epinephrine auto-injectors in a school setting
1.12 according to a condition-specific protocol as authorized under section 148.235, subdivision
1.13 8. Notwithstanding any limitation in sections 148.171 to 148.285, licensed practical nurses
1.14 may administer epinephrine auto-injectors in a school setting according to a condition-specific
1.15 protocol that does not reference a specific patient and that specifies the circumstances under
1.16 which the epinephrine auto-injector is to be administered, when caring for a patient whose
1.17 condition falls within the protocol.

1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2024."

1.19 Amend the title accordingly
