(a) Notwithstanding section 151.37, districts and schools may obtain and possess epinephrine auto-injectors to 1.5 be maintained and administered by school personnel to a student or other individual if, in 1.6 good faith, it is determined that person is experiencing anaphylaxis regardless of whether 1.7 the student or other individual has a prescription for an epinephrine auto-injector. The 1.8 administration of an epinephrine auto-injector in accordance with this section is not the 1.9 practice of medicine. 1.10
- 1.11 (b) Registered nurses may administer epinephrine auto-injectors in a school setting
- 1.12 according to a condition-specific protocol as authorized under section 148.235, subdivision
- 1.13 <u>8. Notwithstanding any limitation in sections 148.171 to 148.285, licensed practical nurses</u>
- 1.14 may administer epinephrine auto-injectors in a school setting according to a condition-specific
- 1.15 protocol that does not reference a specific patient and that specifies the circumstances under
- 1.16 which the epinephrine auto-injector is to be administered, when caring for a patient whose
- 1.17 <u>condition falls within the protocol.</u>
