

1.1 Senator ..... moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS3567A-1)  
1.2 to S.F. No. 3567 as follows:

1.3 Page 28, delete sections 4 and 5

1.4 Page 29, delete section 6 and insert:

1.5 "Sec. 4. Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 122A.181, subdivision 3, is amended  
1.6 to read:

1.7 Subd. 3. **Term of license and renewal.** (a) The Professional Educator Licensing and  
1.8 Standards Board must issue an initial Tier 1 license for a term of one year. A Tier 1 license  
1.9 may be renewed subject to paragraphs (b) and (c).

1.10 (b) The Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board must renew a Tier 1  
1.11 license if:

1.12 (1) the district or charter school requesting the renewal demonstrates that it has posted  
1.13 the teacher position but was unable to hire an acceptable teacher with a Tier 2, 3, or 4 license  
1.14 for the position;

1.15 (2) the teacher holding the Tier 1 license took a content examination in accordance with  
1.16 section 122A.185 and submitted the examination results to the teacher's employing district  
1.17 or charter school within one year of the board approving the request for the initial Tier 1  
1.18 license;

1.19 (3) the teacher holding the Tier 1 license participated in cultural competency training  
1.20 consistent with section 120B.30, subdivision 8, within one year of the board approving the  
1.21 request for the initial Tier 1 license; and

1.22 (4) the teacher holding the Tier 1 license met the mental illness training renewal  
1.23 requirement under section 122A.187, subdivision 6.

1.24 The requirement in clause (2) does not apply to a teacher that teaches a class in a career and  
1.25 technical education or career pathways course of study.

1.26 (c) A Tier 1 license must not be renewed more than three times, unless the requesting  
1.27 district or charter school can show good cause for additional renewals. A Tier 1 license  
1.28 issued to teach (1) a class or course in a career and technical education or career pathway  
1.29 course of study, or (2) in a shortage area, as defined in section 122A.06, subdivision 6, may  
1.30 be renewed without limitation. A Tier 1 license issued to teach special education may not  
1.31 be renewed more than two times.

2.1 Sec. 5. Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 122A.182, subdivision 7, is amended  
2.2 to read:

2.3 Subd. 7. **Mentorship and evaluation.** (a) A teacher holding a Tier 2 license must  
2.4 participate in the employing district or charter school's mentorship and evaluation program,  
2.5 including an individual growth and development plan that includes cultural competency  
2.6 under section 120B.30, subdivision 8.

2.7 (b) A teacher holding a Tier 2 license must participate in an evaluation aligned, to the  
2.8 extent practicable, with the evaluation under section 122A.40, subdivision 8, or section  
2.9 122A.41, subdivision 5.

2.10 (c) A teacher holding a Tier 2 license must participate in the employing district or charter  
2.11 school's professional development."
