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## **S.F. No. 3949 – Relocation of high voltage transmission lines (as amended by the A-1)**

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**S.F. 3949** allows the commissioner of transportation to construct, place, or maintain high voltage transmission lines along highways and roadways, except as deemed necessary to protect public safety or ensure the proper function of the highway.

If the commissioner denies a high voltage transmission line collocation request, the commissioner must submit the reasons for the denial to the chairs and ranking minority members of the committees with jurisdiction over energy and transportation, the Public Utilities Commission executive secretary, and the commissioner of commerce, for their review, within 90 days of the denial.
