Re: SF 4159 – Landlord Acceptance of ITINs

Dear Chair Frentz, Ranking Minority Member Mathews, and Members of the Committee:

Legal Aid writes in support of SF 4159, which would amend Chapter 216B – the Public Utilities Act – to enable an applicant to provide an individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN) in lieu of a Social Security number on an application for utility service. Legal Aid provides civil legal services to low-income Minnesotans, Minnesotans with disabilities, and elder Minnesotans, statewide, to help them meet their basic needs. Legal Aid's Legal Services Advocacy Project provides legislative and administrative advocacy on behalf of our clients and all low-income Minnesotans.

Enactment of this bill would be another building block to support two critical goals: creating a welcoming and nondiscriminatory environment for all to further a fundamental Minnesota value; and helping everyone access essential utility services. We urge passage of SF 4159.
