RE: Concerns with expansion of firearms during deer season and repeal of shotgun zone

Dear Chair Hawj and Members of the Environment, Climate, and Legacy Committee:

On behalf of the Olmsted County Board of Commissioners, I write to share our concerns with <u>SF</u> 3808 which allows the use of all legal firearms statewide during the regular firearms deer season and repeals the shotgun zone. The county has significant safety concerns with expanding rifle use statewide given the topography, land use, population density, and structure density in our county.

Rochester, the third largest city in the state, is in Olmsted County. While the county has rural areas, our population is increasing and the county is becoming more urban and suburban. Olmsted County has many suburban residential developments, hobby farms, and cities that contain or adjoin woodlands and farm fields that are likely places for hunting and other game. With the very long trajectory for rifle shots we believe that repeal of the shotgun only zone and expansion of all firearms during the regular firearms deer season will place people at risk of injury or death and property at needless risk of damage.

If the Committee opts to move SF 3808 forward, Olmsted County respectfully requests to be exempted from the proposed change so the shot gun only zone would remain in effect in Olmsted County.
