1.2 to S.F. No. 3887 as follows:

1.3 Page 41, after line 31, insert:

1.4 "Sec. 23. Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 325E.3892, subdivision 2, is  
1.5 amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 2. **Prohibition.** (a) A person must not import, manufacture, sell, hold for sale, or  
1.7 distribute or offer for use in this state any covered product containing:

1.8 (1) lead at more than 0.009 percent by total weight (90 parts per million); or

1.9 (2) cadmium at more than 0.0075 percent by total weight (75 parts per million).

1.10 (b) This section does not apply to covered products containing lead or cadmium, or both,  
1.11 when regulation is preempted by federal law.

1.12 (c) Notwithstanding paragraph (a), a person may import, manufacture, sell, hold for sale,  
1.13 or distribute a key fob that contains lead if the commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency  
1.14 determines that the use of lead in key fobs is a currently unavoidable use. For purposes of  
1.15 this paragraph, a "key fob" is a physical device which is capable of electronically transmitting  
1.16 a key code to a vehicle starting system without physical connection, other than its presence  
1.17 in the vehicle, between the device and the vehicle."
