

1.1 **Senator Marty from the Committee on Finance, to which was re-referred**

1.2 **S.F. No. 5116:** A bill for an act relating to state government; appropriating money from
1.3 outdoor heritage, clean water, parks and trails, and arts and cultural heritage funds; modifying
1.4 appropriation; amending Laws 2023, chapter 40, article 3, sections 2, subdivision 1; 3; 4.

1.5 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.6 Page 1, line 22, delete "180,711,000" and insert "192,711,000"

1.7 Page 9, line 5, delete "89,294,000" and insert "101,294,000"

1.8 Page 18, line 6, delete "first" and insert "second"

1.9 Page 19, after line 32, insert:

1.10 **"(aa) Protecting Upper Mississippi River from**
1.11 **Invasive Carp**

1.12 \$12,000,000 the second year is to the
1.13 commissioner of natural resources to fund
1.14 activities to protect the Upper Mississippi
1.15 River from invasive carp. Activities within
1.16 this appropriation include agreements with
1.17 federal partners, such as the United States Fish
1.18 and Wildlife Service, to design, construct, and
1.19 begin the operation and maintenance of a
1.20 structural deterrent for invasive carp at Lock
1.21 and Dam No. 5 on the Mississippi River to
1.22 protect Minnesota's aquatic habitat through an
1.23 adaptive management approach. Deterrent
1.24 design must be fully completed within two
1.25 years of the date of this appropriation.
1.26 Deterrent installation must be completed by
1.27 June 30, 2029. Funds not spent or obligated
1.28 for design installation and operation of the
1.29 deterrent may be used for testing technologies
1.30 to support the future effectiveness of the
1.31 deterrent. A detailed accomplishment plan
1.32 must be submitted to and approved by the
1.33 Lessard-Sams Outdoor Heritage Council prior
1.34 to release of funds. This appropriation is
1.35 available until June 30, 2029."

2.1 Page 24, after line 16, insert:

2.2 "(c) The availability of the appropriation in
2.3 Laws 2019, First Special Session chapter 2,
2.4 article 1, section 2, subdivision 5, paragraph
2.5 (o), Restoring Upper Mississippi River at Lake
2.6 Pepin, is extended to June 30, 2028."

2.7 Page 40, line 15, delete "1,845,000" and insert "1,895,000"

2.8 Page 41, after line 2, insert:

2.9 "(d) Capri Theater
2.10 \$200,000 in the second year is for a grant to
2.11 Capri Theater to enrich and expand youth and
2.12 adult arts programming and effective arts and
2.13 educational offerings for youth, families, and
2.14 emerging and accomplished artists."

2.15 Page 42, delete lines 16 to 25

2.16 Reletter the paragraphs in sequence

2.17 Page 42, line 29, delete "3,776,000" and insert "3,726,000"

2.18 Page 43, line 24, delete "\$2,700,000" and insert "\$2,500,000"

2.19 Page 45, after line 15, insert:

2.20 "(e) Art From the Inside
2.21 \$150,000 the second year is for a grant to Art
2.22 From the Inside to use the arts, including but
2.23 not limited to visual art, poetry, literature,
2.24 theater, dance, and music, to address the
2.25 supportive, therapeutic, and rehabilitative
2.26 needs of incarcerated persons and persons on
2.27 supervised release and promote a safer
2.28 correctional facility and community
2.29 environment."


2.30 And when so amended the bill do pass. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
