

1.1 **Senator Marty from the Committee on Finance, to which was re-referred**

1.2 **S.F. No. 4312:** A bill for an act relating to firearms; establishing standards for the safe
1.3 storage of firearms and criminal penalties for failing to meet those standards; amending
1.4 Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 609.666; Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section
1.5 624.713, subdivision 1.

1.6 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.7 Page 1, line 13, delete "permanently"

1.8 Page 1, line 18, delete "tamperproof" and insert "tamper-resistant"

1.9 Page 1, line 20, after "ceiling," insert "including a closet,"

1.10 Page 2, line 1, delete everything after "is" and insert "used exclusively for: (1) the storage
1.11 of firearms, ammunition, components of firearms or ammunition, or equipment for
1.12 firearm-related activities including but not limited to reloading ammunition, gunsmithing,
1.13 and firearm cleaning and maintenance; or (2) conducting firearm-related activities, including
1.14 but not limited to reloading ammunition, gunsmithing and firearm cleaning and maintenance."

1.15 Page 2, delete line 2

1.16 Page 2, line 19, before "misdemeanor" insert "petty"

1.17 Page 3, line 1, after "while" insert "being"

1.18 Page 3, delete section 2 and insert:

1.19 "Sec. 2. DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS; APPROPRIATION.


1.20 \$10,000 in fiscal year 2025 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
1.21 of corrections for costs associated with this act. The base for this appropriation is \$19,000
1.22 beginning in fiscal year 2026."

1.23 Amend the title as follows:

1.24 Page 1, line 3, after the semicolon, insert "appropriating money;"

1.25 Amend the title numbers accordingly

1.26 And when so amended the bill do pass. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
