ARTICLE 1 APPROPRIATIONS

Provides appropriations and modifies appropriations to the Department of Employment and Economic Development and Explore Minnesota. See spreadsheet for details.

ARTICLE 2 POLICY

Section 1 removes the requirement that a community-based organization have an annual budget of no more the \$1,000,000 to be awarded funding to provide skills training under the targeted populations workforce grant program. This is from the underlying bill, **S.F. 5289** (Champion).

Section 2 establishes Explore Minnesota Film, currently operated by the Minnesota Film and TV Board, as an office within Explore Minnesota. Provides duties for the director of Explore Minnesota Film. Sections 2 to 7 are from **S.F. 4446** (Hauschild).

Sections 3 to 7 make conforming changes consistent with **section 2**.

Section 8 provides objectives for the Change Starts with Community program, which provides job training programs for at-risk youth and adults, provides mentorships, employment skills, and job opportunities. Specifies partnership organizations for the program. Requires a report. This is from **S.F. 4808** (Champion).

Section 9 establishes a Shakopee workforce development scholarship pilot program and a temporary income tax credit for employers who contribute to scholarships for program applicants. Requires an annual report regarding the scholarship program. This is from **S.F. 3223** (Pratt).

Section 10 instructs the Revisor to codify a portion of a session law as section 116J.8752, subdivision 4a, to allow for the commissioner of employment and economic development to make

transfers between the Minnesota Forward Fund account, the Minnesota Climate Innovation Authority account, and the State Competitiveness Fund account.

Section 11 repeals the Airport Infrastructure Renewal (AIR) Grant program statute.
