


2022-2023 ANNUAL TEACHER SURVEY MN RESPONSE SUMMARY

The 2022-2023 Annual Teacher Survey had 485 respondents

who taught in Minnesota schools.

While 72% reported receiving some material or financial classroom support from their school, 75% received \$250 or less and 79% reported the materials lasting half the school year or less.



100% of respondents reported spending money out of pocket on their students and classrooms in the 2022-2023 school year, with 58% spending \$250 or more



CRITICALLY IMPORTANT

Respondents overwhelmingly described the KINFTRC as "critically" or "very" important to **improving the quality of their teaching** as well as their **students' class participation, class preparedness, confidence levels, interest in learning, self-esteem,** and **social engagement.** Top 10 Requested Supplies Pencils Markers Notebooks Folders Dry erase markers Crayons Paper Glue sticks Colored pencils Books (non-textbooks)
