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## S.F. No. 2618 – Increasing access to rigorous coursework (as proposed to be amended by the A-2 amendment)

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## Section 1. Advance equity in rigorous courses pilot program.

- **Subd. 1. Pilot program established.** Establishes the pilot program to increase access to rigorous coursework in six school districts or charter schools during the 2025-2026 to 2027-2028 school years.
- **Subd. 2. Definitions.** Provides definitions applicable to the pilot program.
- **Subd. 3. Automatic enrollment.** Requires participating schools to adopt a policy to automatically enroll students in the pilot program. Provides certain policy requirements. Provides that a parent may opt the student out of enrollment in the rigorous coursework.
- **Subd. 4. Participation requirements.** Requires certain teacher recruitment, parental notification, tutoring, and data collection activities of participating schools.
- **Subd. 5. Application process.** Establishes a process for districts to apply to the commissioner of education for participation in the pilot program. Requires the commissioner to select at least one district enrolling a high percentage of American Indian students for participation, and select other participants to ensure a representative participation. Provides other selection criteria.
- **Subd. 6. Grant uses.** Authorizes participants to use pilot program grant funds to pay for AP course fees, teacher training, textbooks, tutoring, administrative expenses, and teacher bonuses.
- **Subd. 7. State report.** Requires that the Department of Education's rigorous course-taking report due in 2029 includes information about the pilot program. Requires certain report content.

<b>Sec. 2. Appropriations.</b> Appropriates money in fiscal year 2025 for the pilot program. Authorizes the commissioner to retain amounts for grant administration.
