## **S.F. No. 4805 – Historic school building preservation allowable use of long-term facilities maintenance revenue**

**Section 1. Long-term facilities maintenance revenue.** Modifies a district's long-term facilities maintenance (LTFM) revenue to include the costs approved by the commissioner for historic school building preservation. Effective for revenue in fiscal year 2026 and later.

**Sec. 2. Historic school building preservation plan.** Authorizes a school district to include a plan to preserve and maintain a historic school building in the district's 10-year LTFM plan. Provides certain criteria for building eligibility. Limits the additional cost to no more than \$200,000 for each qualifying historic school building. Effective for revenue in fiscal year 2026 and later.
