RE: SF 5252 – **Support**

To Chairwoman Kunesh and distinguished members of the Committee:

On behalf of the Smart Heart Sports Coalition, I write to express our strong support and appreciation for including funding and language for the Cardiac Emergency Response Plans in the Omnibus Education Finance bill (SF 5252). This provision ensures that public schools throughout the state will have in place best-practice, evidence-based policies that will help to save the lives of young people who experience sudden cardiac arrest (SCA) and similar cardiac emergencies.

Launched in March of 2023, the Smart Heart Sports Coalition is comprised of leading health and patient advocacy groups, as well as major sports leagues and organizations – nearly 40 stakeholders in all. We have come together for a nationwide advocacy campaign to raise awareness and drive adoption of policies proven to prevent fatalities from SCA within school communities. These core, life-saving policies are as follows:

- Clearly-marked automated external defibrillators (or AEDs) at or within 1-3 minutes of each high school athletic venue where practices, competitions, or other events are held;
- An athletic Emergency Response Plan that is specific to each athletic venue, and posted, widely-distributed, regularly rehearsed, and updated annually, if needed; and
- Education and training in CPR, including AED use, for high school coaches and other key personnel.

Adopting these policies is critical, especially given that sudden cardiac arrest is the leading cause of sudden death among young athletes.

With the inclusion of CERPS in the Omnibus Education Funding bill, SF 5252 does just that, thereby ensuring Minnesota is a leader in protecting young athletes from a preventable fatal injury. Specifically, the measure requires every public school to adopt and rehearse a CERP, which specifies in writing the specific steps school personnel must take to immediately and effectively respond to a student or other individual who experiences a sudden cardiac arrest or similar life-threatening emergency while on school grounds or at a school-sponsored activity.

These plans will ensure Minnesota's school communities are better equipped and prepared to respond to a SCA if and when they occur.

We, therefore, urge the committee and entire legislature to pass the CERP provisions as part of the Omnibus Education Funding bill. Doing so will expand and support a community of lifesavers in Minnesota and represent a major victory for students throughout the state.
