

1.1 Senator ..... moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS5252A-4)  
1.2 to S.F. No. 5252 as follows:

1.3 Page 32, line 15, delete "25,300,000" and insert "23,800,000"

1.4 Page 33, after line 18, insert:

1.5 "Subd. 6. Evidence-based reading instruction training reimbursement. (a) To  
1.6 reimburse teachers for evidence-based reading instruction training:

1.7 \$ 1,500,000 ..... 2025

1.8 (b) A teacher who is currently teaching in a Minnesota school district, charter school,  
1.9 or cooperative unit must apply in the form and manner determined by the commissioner to  
1.10 be eligible to receive reimbursement for the actual cost the applicant paid for an  
1.11 evidence-based reading instruction training, including tuition, books, and other instructional  
1.12 materials. The commissioner must establish procedures to ensure that the costs reimbursed  
1.13 under this section have not been reimbursed by the applicant's employer or another source.  
1.14 If the appropriation is insufficient, the commissioner must prorate the amount paid to  
1.15 applicants seeking reimbursement.

1.16 (c) An eligible evidence-based reading instruction training is an approved professional  
1.17 development program identified under Minnesota Statutes, section 120B.124, subdivision  
1.18 1, paragraph (a), clause (2), that was completed by the applicant between January 1, 2020,  
1.19 and June 30, 2023.

1.20 (d) This is a onetime appropriation."
