Dear Chair Dziedzic and Members of the State and Local Government and Veterans Committee:

Metro Cities, representing the collective interests of cities in the metropolitan area, supports SF 3526 (Mohamed), which is being heard in the State and Local Government committee on Tuesday.

To serve their local citizens and communities, city officials must have sufficient local control and decision-making authority. SF 3526 authorizes any city to adopt a pedestrian mall ordinance within the city's right-of-way. The choice to establish a pedestrian mall will be community and context dependent. The passage of this legislation would provide cities an important optional tool as they continue to design, construct, and maintain their local transportation systems in a manner that maximizes livability and safety for all modes of travel.
