This bill amends the statute that allows a city of the first class to establish a neighborhood revitalization program, by modifying the membership of the policy board. Each city that develops a program must establish a policy board. Current law includes members of the city council, a representative from the city's house of representatives delegation and a representative from the city's state senate delegation. This bill changes the membership to allow one member or designee of the city county, and the house and senate representatives must be appointed by their respective delegations. Also, only members, designees, or representatives appointed have the power to appoint new members to the board.
