1.8	Subdivision 1. Generally. (a) A nonresident of the state of Minnesota who is not seeking
1.9	licensure in Minnesota and intends to practice in Minnesota must apply to the board for
1.10	guest licensure. An applicant must apply for guest licensure at least 30 days prior to the
1.11	expected date of practice in Minnesota and is subject to approval by the board or its designee.
1.12	(b) To be eligible for licensure under this section, the applicant must:
1.13	(1) have a license, certification, or registration in good standing to practice marriage and
1.14	family therapy from another jurisdiction;
1.15	(2) have a graduate degree in marriage and family therapy from a regionally accredited
