Dear Chair Dziedzic and State and Local Government and Veterans Committee Members:

MRRA supports the goals of SF 3561, the Packaging Waste and Cost Reduction Act to significantly reduce waste going to landfills by reducing packaging waste, increasing reusable packaging, and moving us beyond the stagnant recycling rates we have been seeing for many years.

MRRA supports a bill that:

- Requires producers of packaging and paper products help solve the waste problems they created and left for our facilities to manage;
- Brings various members of the waste industry, local government, and community representatives to the table to help develop solutions; and
- Contains strong agency oversight and enforcement capacity to assure the producers follow through as required in SF 3561.
