SF 4788 repeals a special law passed in 1979 that phased out the authority of the city of St. Paul to impose or collect a franchise fee from a public utility based on the sale of gas or electricity to residential customers from November through April. This section is effective the day after the city council approves by resolution and the chief clerical officer files the approval with the secretary of state.
