Bill Description

This bill establishes a task force charged to assess Minnesota's guardianship laws and practices with stakeholders to identify changes that improve the civil rights, due process, less restrictive practices, increasing the number of qualified guardians, ongoing funding for guardians, and exploring potential certification or licensure for guardians.

Assumptions

This task force requires 25 members to be appointed, including four legislators, that have per diems and compensation, per Minn Stat 15.059, and the task force would be hosted and supported by the Minnesota Council on Disability.

We assume that the 8 state agency representatives will not be paid per diem, the 12 members of the public will be eligible for the \$55 per diem, and the 1 judiciary member and 4 legislative members will be paid that their respective rates, in addition to milage or meal reimbursements.

The task force would begin July 1, 2025, first convene by September 1, 2025, meet at least quarterly, and the final report would be due to the legislature no later than December 21, 2026.

The task force would include statewide participation using hybrid meeting space options, Open Meeting Law compliance, which requires a physical location for the public to attend, when possible.

Based on the scope and deliverables, we would need 1.0 FTE (SPA Prin) staff to provide project management coordination, Open Meeting Law compliance, and ensure administrative and technology support is provided.

Additionally, we assume that we will use independent meeting facilitators, note takers, and they would write the report on the behalf of the task force through a contracted vendor.

We are also assuming that the task force will look at least two other state's guardianship reform packages to identify best practices and current trends.

We assume that the public input opportunities will include public comment, opportunities for submitted documents and letters, and information will be shared with the public throughout the process.

Specific targeted engagement through the consultants will also gather input and feedback from the judicial branch, advocacy groups, individuals under guardianship, people who operate as guardians, and attorneys who work in this space.

MAD has indicated that their consulting rate will be updated to \$150 per hour by the project's start time and rates are dependent on if Management Analysis and Development's capacity to support this work or if outside consultants are procured. External consultants typically are more expensive than MAD.

Lastly, we assume that MCD will incur no costs or duties if this task force is not funded by the 2025 legislature

Bill Description

The bill creates a Legislative Task Force on Guardianship of which membership includes two representatives and two senators. Appointments must be made by June 30, 2025, and the first meeting of the task force must be held by September 1, 2025, if an appropriation is made by that date for the task force. The group must meet at least quarterly. Members may receive compensation and reimbursement for expenses as governed by MS 15.059, Subd 3. The task force must submit a report by December 31, 2026, at which the task force expires or by June 1, 2025, if FY26 funds are not appropriated for the operations of the task force.

The Minnesota Council on Disabilities (MCD) must provide administrative support, research support, and meeting location to the task force.

Assumptions

The establishment of the task force is contingent on funds for the operation of the task force being appropriated during the 2025 legislative session. The following is the projected cost of the legislative members' participation in the meetings of the task force. That cost is a secondary cost and is being provided for informational purposes. The secondary projected costs are not included in the cost table of the fiscal note.

- The task force will meet four times in FY26 with three meetings occurring during legislative session interim and one meeting occurring during legislative session. During FY27, the task force will meeting two times with all meetings occurring during legislative session interim. All meetings will be held within the Capitol campus with limited remote participation.
- 2. MCD will provide support to the task force.
- 3. MCD will address the meeting participation cost of the public members of the task force and any reimbursement of expenses of the state agency members of the task force in their fiscal note.
- 4. The bill does not provide for payment of per diems or for the reimbursement of expenses of legislators serving on the task force. However, legislative members could request reimbursement for expenses of engaging in legislative activity. This fiscal note is based on the assumption that the legislative members will be paid per diems and reimbursement for their expenses from the House and Senate. New funds will be needed for the House and Senate.
- 5. Legislative member meeting participation costs includes the following per member, per legislative interim meeting: per diem (\$86 senators, \$86 representatives), and \$102 round trip mileage (152 round trip mile average). Half of the legislative members will be reimbursed for lodging expenses (\$150/night senators, \$175/night representatives). New funds will be needed for the House and Senate for the legislative member meeting cost.
