S.F. No. 3572 – Minnesota People Over Parking Act

This bill prohibits a political subdivision from imposing a minimum parking mandate for residential, commercial, or industrial properties within its jurisdiction. The term “minimum parking mandate” is defined as a law, rule, or ordinance that specifies a minimum number of off-street vehicle parking spaces, including a garage or other enclosed area. This section does not prohibit political subdivisions from passing an ordinance under Minnesota Statutes, section 169.346, subdivision 4, which allows the city to establish a citizen enforcement program to enforce the parking restrictions relating to parking spaces for the physically handicapped.
