**S.F. No. 3257 - Bilingual materials required at deputy registrar and driver's license agent locations (as proposed to be amended by SCS3257A-2)**

**S.F. 3257** requires the Division of Driver and Vehicle Services (DVS) to produce materials in a language other than English if a substantial portion of the total number of yearly transactions are conducted in a language other than English. Effective October 1, 2024.

**Subdivision 1** defines terms.

**Subdivision 2** requires the commissioner of public safety to determine if deputy registrar and driver's license agent locations serve a substantial number of non-English speaking people on a yearly basis, defined as 20 percent of their yearly transactions.

**Subdivision 3** requires DVS to provide materials in languages other than English to locations determined to serve a substantial number of non-English speaking people. Specifies that materials must be provided free-of-charge. Requires deputy registrars and driver's license agents to determine whether accessible languages are available from DVS upon request.

**Subdivision 4** requires the determination in subdivision 2 apply to deputy registrars and driver's license agents at county service offices.

**Subdivision 5** requires a report to the legislature on the bilingual materials requirement established in this section.
