1.7	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 169.829, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.8	to read:
1.9	Subd. 5. Sewage septic tank trucks. (a) For the purposes of this subdivision, "emergency
1.10	pumping services" means a sewage septic tank truck's response to:
1.11	(1) uncontrolled and unintended seepage of the contents of a septic system into the
1.12	ground, around a structure, or into a body of surface water;
1.13	(2) damage or malfunction to a septic system that requires removal of the contents of
1.14	the septic system for repair or maintenance; or
1.15	(3) a condition that creates an immediate hazard to the health, welfare, or safety of a
1.16	person.
1.17	(b) When a sewage septic tank truck used exclusively to transport sewage from septic
1.18	or holding tanks is performing emergency pumping services, sections 169.823 and 169.826
1.19	to 169.828 do not apply, and the weight limitations under section 169.824 are increased by
1.20	ten percent when transporting sewage from a single point of service to the point of unloading.
