S.F. 4599 modifies requirements relating to security services within the State Capitol Complex.

Section 1 clarifies that security services for the Capitol are provided by the Capitol Complex Security Division in the Department of Public Safety.

Section 2 makes a conforming change.

Section 3 defines the term “Capitol complex” to include state-owned or state-leased buildings within the Capitol area or state-owned or state-leased spaces in buildings that house Capitol complex offices provided to a state constitutional officer.

Section 4 provides an effective date.
