**S.F. No. 927 - Transporting petroleum products requirements (as proposed to be amended by A-1 amendment)**

**S.F. 927** authorizes a person who is at least 18 years of age to transport the petroleum products in certain containers. Under current law, a person who is at least 18 years of age may only transport petroleum products in intrastate commerce in a tank truck vehicle. Requires drivers who operate a tank truck vehicle with a capacity of less than 3,500 gallons to transport petroleum products must have a valid commercial driver's license with endorsements for hazardous materials and tank vehicles and be at least 18 years old. Repeals the current law governing the age limit of a driver of a motorized tank truck vehicle and provides new specifications and clarifications related to driver's license and endorsements.
