1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 221.0269, subdivision 4, is  
1.4 amended to read:

1.5 Subd. 4. **Intrastate transportation; heating fuel.** (a) If a regional emergency has been  
1.6 declared by the President of the United States or by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety  
1.7 Administration pursuant to United States Code, title 49, section 390.23(a), ~~and the declaration~~  
1.8 ~~includes heating fuel as a covered commodity~~, the federal regulations incorporated into  
1.9 section 221.0314, subdivision 9, for hours of service do not apply to drivers engaged in  
1.10 intrastate transportation of ~~heating fuel~~ products when the driver is:

1.11 (1) driving a vehicle designed and exclusively used to transport fuel products; and

1.12 (2) carrying only fuel products as defined in section 296A.01.

1.13 (b) The relief provided by paragraph (a) only applies when the fuel product being  
1.14 transported is included in the emergency declaration as a covered commodity.

1.15 (c) Notwithstanding the relief provided in paragraph (a), a driver may not exceed a total  
1.16 of 14 hours combined on-duty and driving time after coming on duty following at least ten  
1.17 consecutive hours off-duty.

1.18 ~~(e)~~ (d) If a driver is operating under the relief provided by paragraph (a), and the  
1.19 declaration is in effect for more than 30 calendar days, the driver must take a 34-hour restart  
1.20 before the driver has been on duty for 30 consecutive days.

1.21 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."
