S.F. No. 4634 – Uniform disability parking sign requirement

S.F. 4634 requires the Minnesota Council on Disability to design a new uniform disability parking sign for use statewide and consistent with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). The newly-designed sign must not display the word or any variation of “handicapped.” Requires property owners and managers where a disability parking sign is located to replace all existing signs with the selected and proposed sign at the owner or manager’s earliest opportunity, but no later than July 1, 2026. If an owner fails to replace old signs with the selected sign by June 1, 2026, the owner or manager is guilty of a misdemeanor and may be fined up to \$500. Effective the day following final enactment.
