S.F. No. 4693 – Canceling and reappropriating previous transportation appropriations

S.F. 4693 cancels and reappropriates a portion of a fiscal year 2022 General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Transportation (MNDOT) for trunk highway and local road projects. The original appropriation was \$30.93 million, with any unexpended portion to be canceled at the end of fiscal year (FY) 2025. The bill has the effect of extending the availability of the original appropriation to the end of FY 2029, with no net impact to the General Fund.

Section 1 cancels \$15.56 million of the original FY 2022 appropriation, which is the estimated uncommitted amount. The cancellation is effective June 30, 2024, and cancels back to the General Fund.

Section 2 appropriates \$15.56 million in FY 2025 from the General Fund to MNDOT for the same purpose as the original FY 2022 appropriation. This is a onetime appropriation and will cancel at the end of FY 2029.

This act is effective the day after final enactment.
