S.F. No. 4895 – Driver’s license online knowledge test provision modification

S.F. 4895 amends the requirement in the statute governing online knowledge tests for driver’s licenses. Under current law, the Division of Driver and Vehicle Services (“DVS”) is required to administer a knowledge examination to an applicant if the applicant has failed three or more knowledge tests. **S.F. 4895** strikes this requirement and authorizes third-party proctors to administer fourth or subsequent examinations for a driver’s license applicant. **Effective** August 1, 2025.
