- 3.17 for offset actions interlinked to trunk highway projects that reduce traffic fatalities or severe
- 3.18 injuries. The base for this appropriation is \$5,000,000 in each of fiscal years 2026 and 2027,
- 3.19 and \$0 in fiscal year 2028 and thereafter.
