Section Summaries

Section 1 (adds Minn. Stat. § 151.212, subd. 4) This section requires a pharmacy to inform patients that accessible prescription drug container labels are available, at no cost, to patients that identify as blind, visually impaired, or otherwise disabled. It further requires pharmacies to provide patients, upon request, with an audible, large print, or braille prescription drug container label.

Paragraph (c) of this section lists availability, formatting, and information requirements for the accessible container label, and paragraph (d) provides an exception from this section for correctional institutions.
