Section 1 requires the commissioner of human services to review current child maltreatment reporting processes and systems in various states and evaluate the costs and benefits of each state system reviewed. Requires the commissioner to consult with stakeholders to develop recommendations to implement a statewide common entry point system for reporting child maltreatment. Additionally requires the commissioner to submit a report by December 1, 2024, detailing the recommendations and publish the report online.
