## **S.F. No. 4204 – Ombudspersons access to the social service information system**

### **Bill Overview**

**S.F. 4204** allows various ombudspersons to access the social service information system (SSIS) and requires the ombudspersons to adhere to the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act.

### **Section Summaries**

**Section 1 (adds 3.9215, subd. 14)** allows the Ombudsperson for American Indian Families, or a designee, access to the SSIS as necessary for the discharge of the ombudsperson’s duties. Requires the ombudsperson and designees to adhere to the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act.

**Section 2 (amends 245.975, subd. 4)** allows the Ombudsperson for Family Child Care Providers, or a designee, access to the SSIS as necessary for the discharge of the ombudsperson’s duties.

**Section 3 (adds 257.0762, subd. 3)** allows each Ombudsperson for Families, or a designee, access to the SSIS as necessary for the discharge of the ombudsperson’s duties. Requires each ombudsperson and designees to adhere to the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act.

**Section 4 (adds 260C.82, subd. 8)** allows the Foster Youth Ombudsperson, or a designee, access to the SSIS as necessary for the discharge of the ombudsperson’s duties. Requires the ombudsperson and designees to adhere to the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act.
