

1.1 **Senator Wiklund from the Committee on Health and Human Services, to which**  
1.2 **was referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 4877:** A bill for an act relating to child protection; modifying membership and  
1.4 requirements for the child mortality review panel; modifying the review process for child  
1.5 fatalities and near fatalities related to maltreatment; modifying the Department of Human  
1.6 Services child systemic critical incident review team requirements; establishing the critical  
1.7 incident public information portal; amending Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section  
1.8 256.01, subdivision 12b; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 260E;  
1.9 repealing Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256.01, subdivisions 12, 12a; Minnesota Rules,  
1.10 part 9560.0232, subpart 5.

1.11 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.12 Page 4, after line 27, insert:

1.13 "(3) the commissioner of health, or a designee;"

1.14 Page 4, line 28, delete "(3)" and insert "(4)"

1.15 Page 4, line 29, delete "(4)" and insert "(5)"

1.16 Page 5, line 2, delete the first "a" and insert "two" and delete "worker" and insert  
1.17 "workers" and after "agency" insert ", with one worker from greater Minnesota and one  
1.18 worker from the seven-county metropolitan area"

1.19 Page 5, line 31, delete "must"

1.20 Page 6, delete lines 1 to 3 and insert:

1.21 "(1) must include any systemic learnings that may improve practice and service delivery;  
1.22 and

1.23 (2) may include policy or practice considerations for systems change."

1.24 Page 6, line 8, delete "must"

1.25 Page 6, delete lines 9 to 11 and insert:

1.26 "(1) must include any systemic learnings that may improve practice and service delivery;  
1.27 and

1.28 (2) may include policy or practice considerations for systems change."

1.29 Page 8, line 22, delete "develop"

1.30 Page 8, line 23, delete "and"

1.31 Page 9, after line 6, insert:

2.1 "Sec. 3. DIRECTION TO COMMISSIONER OF HUMAN SERVICES; CRITICAL  
2.2 INCIDENT PUBLIC INFORMATION PORTAL.


2.3 The commissioner must begin the development of the critical incident public information  
2.4 portal required under Minnesota Statutes, section 260E.39, subdivision 8, by July 1, 2024.  
2.5 The portal must be functional, available to the public, and fulfill all the requirements under  
2.6 Minnesota Statutes, section 260E.39, subdivision 8, by July 1, 2025.

2.7 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."

2.8 Renumber the sections in sequence

2.9 Amend the title numbers accordingly

2.10 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Judiciary  
2.11 and Public Safety. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
