1.5 A Medical Services Division is created in the Office of Emergency Medical Services.

1.6 The Medical Services Division shall be under the supervision of a deputy director of medical
1.7 services appointed by the director. The deputy director, under the direction of the director,
1.8 shall enforce and coordinate the laws, rules, and policies assigned by the director, which
1.9 may include overseeing the clinical aspects of prehospital medical care and education
1.10 programs for emergency medical service personnel.

1.11 Sec. 5. **[144E.016] AMBULANCE SERVICES DIVISION.**

1.12 An Ambulance Services Division is created in the Office of Emergency Medical Services.

1.13 The Ambulance Services Division shall be under the supervision of a deputy director of
1.14 ambulance services appointed by the director. The deputy director, under the direction of
1.15 the director, shall enforce and coordinate the laws, rules, and policies assigned by the director,
1.16 which may include operating standards and licensing of ambulance services; registration
1.17 and operation of medical response units; establishment and modification of primary service
1.18 areas; authorization of ambulance services to provide service in a primary service area and
1.19 revocation such authorization; coordination of ambulance services within regions and across
1.20 the state; and administration of grants.

1.21 Sec. 6. **[144E.017] EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE PROVIDERS DIVISION.**

1.22 An Emergency Medical Service Providers Division is created in the Office of Emergency
1.23 Medical Services. The Emergency Medical Service Providers Division shall be under the
1.24 supervision of a deputy director of emergency medical service providers appointed by the
1.25 director. The deputy director, under the direction of the director, shall enforce and coordinate
1.26 the laws, rules, and policies assigned by the director, which may include certification and
1.27 registration of individual emergency medical service providers; overseeing worker safety,
1.28 worker well-being, and working conditions; investigation of workplace violations;
1.29 implementation of education programs; and administration of grants."

2.21 Subdivision 1. Establishment; membership. The Labor and Emergency Medical Service
2.22 Providers Advisory Council is established and consists of the following members:

2.23 (1) one emergency medical services provider of any type from each of the designated
2.24 regional emergency medical services systems, appointed by their respective regional
2.25 emergency services boards;

2.26 (2) one emergency medical technician instructor, appointed by ...;

2.27 (3) two members with experience working as a labor union representative representing
2.28 emergency medical service providers, appointed by ...;

2.29 (4) one emergency medical service provider based in a fire department, appointed by
2.30 ...; and

3.1 (5) one emergency medical service provider not based in a fire department, appointed
3.2 by

3.3 Subd. 2. **Terms, compensation, removal, vacancies, and expiration.** Compensation
3.4 and reimbursement for expenses for members appointed under subdivision 1; removal of
3.5 members; filling of vacancies of members; and, except for initial appointments, membership
3.6 terms are governed by section 15.059. Notwithstanding section 15.059, subdivision 6, the
3.7 Labor and Emergency Medical Service Providers Advisory Council does not expire.

3.8 Subd. 3. **Officers; meetings.** (a) The Labor and Emergency Medical Service Providers
3.9 Advisory Council must elect a chair and vice-chair from among its membership and may
3.10 elect other officers as the advisory council deems necessary.

3.11 (b) The Labor and Emergency Medical Service Providers Advisory Council must meet
3.12 quarterly or at the call of the chair.

3.13 (c) Meetings of the Labor and Emergency Medical Service Providers Advisory Council
3.14 are subject to chapter 13D.

3.15 Subd. 4. **Duties.** The Labor and Emergency Medical Service Providers Advisory Council
3.16 must review and make recommendations to the director and deputy director of emergency
3.17 medical service providers on the laws, rules, and policies assigned to the Emergency Medical
3.18 Service Providers Division and other topics as directed by the director.

3.30 (2) seven members shall serve three-year terms.

4.2 of the Labor and Emergency Medical Service Providers Advisory Council by February 1,
4.3 2025.
