1.8Laws 2023, chapter 70, article 20, to the commissioner of human services from the general

1.10fiscal years indicated for each purpose. The figures "2024" and "2025" used in this article

1.11mean that the addition to or subtraction from the appropriation listed under them is available

1.12for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, or June 30, 2025, respectively.
