

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 5385 as follows:

1.2 Page 63, after line 29, insert:

1.3 **"(b) Minnesota Food Shelf Program.**

1.4 \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2025 is for the

1.5 Minnesota food shelf program under

1.6 Minnesota Statutes, section 256E.34. This is

1.7 a onetime appropriation.

1.8 **(c) American Indian Food Sovereignty**

1.9 **Funding Program. \$1,000,000 in fiscal year**

1.10 2025 is for the American Indian food

1.11 sovereignty funding program under Minnesota

1.12 Statutes, section 256E.342. This is a onetime

1.13 appropriation and is available until June 30,

1.14 2026.

1.15 **(d) Minnesota Food Bank Funding.**

1.16 \$2,000,000 in fiscal year 2025 is for

1.17 Minnesota's regional food banks that the

1.18 commissioner contracts with for the purposes

1.19 of the Emergency Food Assistance Program

1.20 (TEFAP). The commissioner shall distribute

1.21 funding under this paragraph in accordance

1.22 with the federal TEFAP formula and

1.23 guidelines of the United States Department of

1.24 Agriculture. Funding must be used by all

1.25 regional food banks to purchase food that will

1.26 be distributed free of charge to TEFAP partner

1.27 agencies. Funding must also cover the

1.28 handling and delivery fees typically paid by

1.29 food shelves to food banks to ensure that costs

1.30 associated with funding under this paragraph

1.31 are not incurred at the local level. This is a

1.32 onetime appropriation."
