

1.1 Senator ..... moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS4699A-2)  
1.2 to S.F. No. 4699 as follows:

1.3 Page 32, after line 26, insert:

1.4 "Sec. 15. **DIRECTION TO THE COMMISSIONER; REIMBURSEMENT FOR**  
1.5 **EXTRACORPOREAL MEMBRANE OXYGENATION CANNULATION AS AN**  
1.6 **OUTPATIENT SERVICE.**

1.7 The commissioner of human services, in consultation with providers and hospitals, shall  
1.8 determine the feasibility of an outpatient reimbursement mechanism for medical assistance  
1.9 coverage of extracorporeal membrane oxygenation (ECMO) cannulation performed outside  
1.10 an inpatient hospital setting or in a self-contained mobile ECMO unit. If an outpatient  
1.11 reimbursement mechanism is feasible, then the commissioner of human services shall  
1.12 develop a recommended payment mechanism. By January 15, 2025, the commissioner of  
1.13 human services shall submit a recommendation and the required legislative language to the  
1.14 chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over  
1.15 health care finance. If such a payment mechanism is infeasible, the commissioner of human  
1.16 services shall submit an explanation as to why it is infeasible."
