1.7 worker platform" means any person, firm, corporation, partnership, or association that
1.8 maintains a system or technology that provides a digital website, smart phone application,
1.9 or software application that facilitates engagement between a license holder under chapter
1.10 144A or 144G and an individual to advertise and be matched for temporary employment
1.11 for direct care services with a license holder.

1.12 Sec. 13. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 144A.61, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.13 to read:

1.14 Subd. 11. **Background study determination notices.** (a) The commissioner of health
1.15 must provide a prospective worker platform with:

1.16 (1) the date of the most recent determination notice for a specified nursing assistant and
1.17 whether the nursing assistant received a disqualification; or

1.18 (2) that no such determination notice exists for a nursing assistant.

1.19 (b) The commissioner of health must not provide registered nursing assistant background
1.20 study information to a prospective worker platform."
