On behalf of partners within West Central Minnesota, we are writing in support of SF3806. Providing funding for Head Start agencies to expand their services to offer child care through local college campuses makes sense. Head Start sets the standards of high-quality care within Minnesota's early care and education system. This concept, coupled with creating child care space on Minnesota's college campuses, helps young parents, along with their children, on multiple fronts.
