Bill Description

SF4635-0 waives tuition for peace officer skills training, appropriates funds, and requires reporting.

Section 1 Subdivision 1 directs the Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities and requests the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota to waive tuition for 12 credits of skills training as part of the Peace Officer Standards and Training Board certified professional peace officer education.

Section 1 Subdivision 2 directs the Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities and the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota to report to the Office of Higher Education, the number of students who received tuition waivers in the previous year, by July 1 of each year, beginning in 2025.

Section 2 appropriates an unspecified amount of funds in FY2025 to the Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities and the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota to pay for the cost of tuition waivers.

Assumptions

SF4635 does not have any additional reporting requirements for the Office of Higher Education (OHE). Receiving the data from the Board of Trustees of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities and the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota will require only around an hour of work each year, is absorbed within our existing data/reporting framework and is not reported as a fiscal impact.

As mentioned in the assumptions section above, SF4635 doe not have a fiscal impact to OHE.

This bill would require Minnesota State colleges and universities to waive tuition costs for 12 credits for skills training as part of the Peace Officer Standards and Training Board certified professional peace officer education.

Assumptions

The applicable tuition rate (regular or differential) per credit for each college is used.

Lost tuition revenue is expressed in this fiscal note as a cost to the state General Fund to replace the lost revenue.
