Sections 1 to 3 amend the Minnesota Private and Out-of-State Public Postsecondary Education Act and Private Career Schools section of law to allow the commissioner of the Office of Higher Education to charge additional fees for an initial application and a renewal registration for applications that require multiple revisions or corrections.

Section 4 amends a previous appropriation for ALS Research to allow up to \$15,000,000 for grants to organizations to award and administer a competitive grant to applicants for ALS research and cancels the appropriation in 2024 instead of 2026.

Section 5 appropriates the amount canceled in Section 4 to the commissioner of the Office of Higher Education for purposes similar to the previous appropriation in Section 4. This is a onetime appropriation available until June 30, 2029.
